

## Our Policies

1. In order to attend Bed & Bark Daycare and Boarding Facility, your dog(s) must be current on the following vaccinations and show proof of these vaccinations prior to entry:
  - Rabies
  - DHLPP (Distemper, Hepatitis, Leptospirosis, Parainfluenza, Parvovirus)
  - Bordetella
  - Canine Influenza (strongly recommended)

You must also show proof of:

- Negative fecal sample (every six months)
- Veterinarian-approved flea and tick preventative (monthly)
- Veterinarian-approved heartworm preventative (monthly)

Failure to meet any of these requirements will result in immediate dismissal from the facility.

2. The minimum age for attending daycare is 4 months. Any dog older than 7 months is required to be spayed or neutered. (Intact males and females cause an overall upset in the pack structure and are at a greater risk for injury from other dogs.)
3. All dogs wishing to attend the Bed & Bark Daycare and Boarding Facility must first undergo a 4-6 hour temperament evaluation. During this assessment, Bed & Bark staff will determine the disposition of your dog and screen for any signs of aggression or antisocial behavior. If the staff determines your dog cannot safely interact with the pack, you will be notified and your pet will continue his or her stay with us in our boarding facility until you arrive.
4. Please refer to our brochure or website for store hours. Unless prior arrangements are made, we impose a \$10.00 late fee for dogs picked up after regular business hours. If your dog is not picked up within 30 minutes of closing, we will assume that you are boarding and will impose the standard overnight charge.
5. Dogs may become possessive of their personal belongings. Accordingly, items such as personal toys or bedding are not permitted at daycare. While our overnight guests are invited to bring their own bedding and toys, please understand that these items are left at your own risk. Bed & Bark is not responsible for loss or damage.
